STEP 2 IDENTIFY YOUR PREUNDERSTANDINGS

We all read the texts through a variety of lenses

We subconsciously bring ideas and understandings to the text based on:

Culture

Experience

Socioeconomic background

Family background and values

Previous exposure to the text



IMPACT OF PREUNDERSTANDINGS

- 1. We fill any gaps and ambiguities in the texts with explanations and background from our cultures.
- 2. They limit the possible understandings of the text that we are able to see.

DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE ORIGINAL AUDIENCE AND CONTEXT AND OURSELVES









JOSHUA 1:1-9 (NIV)

After the death of Moses the servant of the LORD, the LORD said to Joshua son of Nun, Moses' aide: ² "Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites. ³ I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses. ⁴ Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Mediterranean Sea in the west. ⁵ No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. As I was with Moses, so I will be with you; I will never leave you nor forsake you. ⁶ Be strong and courageous, because you will lead these people to inherit the land I swore to their ancestors to give them.



⁷ "Be strong and very courageous. Be careful to obey all the law my servant Moses gave you; do not turn from it to the right or to the left, that you may be successful wherever you go. ⁸ Keep this Book of the Law always on your lips; meditate on it day and night, so that you may be careful to do everything written in it. Then you will be prosperous and successful. ⁹ Have I not commanded you? Be strong and courageous. Do not be afraid; do not be discouraged, for the LORD your God will be with you wherever you go."
